
Instructions for Uploading GPS DPI Entries

This document covers the process of uploading your digital processed images (DPI) to the Garden Photographic Society online competition. For help preparing your images to be compatible with the requirements for a DPI competition, see "How to Prepare GPS DPI Entries" found on the Garden Photographic Society Website Download page. https://gardenphoto.org/downloads/

After preparing your images for competition, you need to submit your images to the on-line Garden competition which is hosted on the 411-Vision website.

Step 1: Go to http://www.411-vision.com/411ClientLogin.html




Step 2: Login to the online competition website using your email and assigned password.

Type your email address that you provided to the club and your assigned password. (The default password is 12345 unless you have changed it.) Then click "Login".

[Note: If you change your email address, make sure you report the change to the club President:

Step 3: On this screen, verify you are connected to the Garden Photographic Society competition site and then click the "Upload" tab (upper right).

This will take you to the following screen.

Step 4: In the competition drop-down box, make sure you have selected the correct competition – check the Month, Class, and Competition Type. Then click "Choose File".

On your computer, navigate to your first image file and click on the filename. For confirmation, your existing filename appears next to "Choose File". In the "Title" box, enter the desired image name. (Remember, this is your opportunity to 'talk' to the judges – use a brief title that explains what the judges should see.) Verify that your name is present and click "Upload Image" – there will be a brief delay as a copy of your file is transferred.

Step 5: After the transfer is complete, a new screen will appear where the background is black and a thumbnail of your image is shown (as it would appear during the competition). Look good? Then you are now ready to upload your next image so click on "Upload Another File". The previous screen will reappear with the "Entry #" box incremented to the next number. Click "Choose File" and repeat the process to select your next image.


For each category, you may enter up to 3 images. You do not have to enter all 3, nor do you have to enter all categories. How much you participate is up to you, but give it a try.


Step 6: When you have uploaded all your entries, click on "Review your images uploaded for open competitions". The following screen is displayed.


Now you can review what images have been uploaded and in what competitions. You can correct errors, e.g., too many images submitted, the wrong image, or the wrong type of image (color in a mono category).

Use the "Remove Image" action to delete any troublesome image. You can then exit the website or return to the upload screen (click on "Upload" tab) to add a different image file.

When finished, sit back, relax, and wait for the results! Good Luck!







Remember, a score is simply feedback. When it is high - it is a job well done and the judges had the same opinion as you did, and when not – remember Photography is art and subject to different opinions. It may also be a call for sharpening a skill or learning a different technique.
