DPI (digital projected images) should be e-mailed to [dpi@gardenphoto.org](mailto:dpi@gardenphoto.org) before 8 pm on the **Sunday** before the competition. You may submit three DPIs in both class A and B

The size of a DPI is limited to 1400 pixels wide and 1050 pixels high (including the border). If the photo has a 4:3 size ratio, a horizontal image will be 1400 x 1050 pixels, and a vertical will be 787 x 1050 pixels. A square ratio photo will be 1050 x 1050 pixels.
